Policies and Guidelines

How to Register

1. **Open and complete the [Registration Form](#).**
2. **Mail, fax or bring the completed form, with payment,** to the Mount's Accounting and Finance Office, Third Floor Bradley Hall, 16300 Old Emmitsburg Road, Emmitsburg, MD 21727. Students must pay at least ½ of all tuition and fees at time of registration with balance due on June 13. On or after June 11, full payment is due at the time of registration. See payment options below.
3. **Register for housing.** Complete the housing application online: www.msmary.edu/summerhousing.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition:	\$550 per credit
Comprehensive Fee:	\$35/session - nonrefundable
Visiting Students:	\$50/one time-nonrefundable
Housing/Meals:	\$805/session - Includes \$425 for double occupancy room and \$380FLEX meal plan.

Financial Aid

Reduced Tuition

All summer school students receive the benefit of reduced tuition. The Mount Summer tuition of \$550 per credit is over 50% off the rate for courses taken during the fall and spring!

Other Aid

Because summer school tuition is significantly discounted from the traditional year, institutional financial aid is not available. However, students may be eligible for other forms of aid, including federal and private student loans and parent (PLUS) loans. Contact the Financial Aid Office directly to discuss your eligibility. Payment Deadlines

1st half of summer tuition/fees: Due at time of registration
2nd half of summer tuition/fees: Due by June 13, 2018
Students registering on or after Monday, June 11, 2018 must pay in full at the time of registration. 6% per annum finance charge will be assessed on unpaid balance. If payment is not received by the due date, you will NOT be permitted to begin classes or move into housing.

Payment Options

Payments can be made by credit card, check or cash.

Credit Card/ACH Payments - Credit card or ACH payments are accepted **online only**.

Credits cards incur 2.75% transaction fee.

Deadline to Drop a Summer course:

Deadline to Withdraw from a Summer course:

Summer II:	July 20, 2018
Summer III:	June 28, 2018

Refund Schedule

Tuition: To receive a full refund of tuition, an official drop form must be submitted to the Registrar's Office by the drop deadlines listed above. Due to the concentrated schedule of classes, no refunds are made for later withdrawals.

Fees: Comprehensive and administrative fees are not refundable.

Room/Board: Up to the drop deadlines listed above, room fee will be prorated. No refunds are made after the drop deadlines.
